

Nursery News October 2019

The children in the nursery have been sharing the story "The Colour Monster". This has helped lots of talk about emotions as the monster changes colour for each feeling. The children have been making faces in the mirror and are starting to understand when they feel happy, angry, grumpy, calm and so on. The children made their own monsters using scissors to snip and sorting by colour as they chose materials. We have been making biscuits at the beginning of each week and started by making and icing happy face biscuits. Each time the children make their biscuits they are becoming more familiar with the language and more independent at mixing, rolling and shaping the dough.
