The children have been finding out about autumn with a focus on nature and changes. We have been exploring autumn leaves and other natural materials like pumpkins and conkers. We did observational paintings of the pumpkins and then investigated what was inside. We collected pumpkin seeds and dyed them with food colouring. We have made hedgehogs from clay. The children have joined in with the book "Goodnight Owl" and learnt about nocturnal animals and also sorted our own routines at home into "night" and "day." We are using collage to make owl pictures. The children have been inquisitive and excited when exploring the dark den.
