Dear Local Resident/Car Park User

RE: CAR PARK RE-MARKING

The Children's Centre and Ambulance Station Car park is being re-marked on Monday 2^{nd} and Tuesday 3^{nd} December. It is imperative that the car park is empty on these days.

It is essential that the car park is empty otherwise the works cannot be carried out and/or Devon County Council will need to consider enforcement action to enable the works to take place.

The car park is solely for the use of the Children's Centre and the Ambulance Station.

Recently this has become a much more serious issues as, at times, the car park has become so filled with cars not parking in designated spaces that the ambulance has been unable to turn and get back out on another emergency visit. This must not happen again and we must ensure that the general public are able to get emergency attention at times when needed.

The nursery also evacuates into a specific area of the car park in the event of a fire, so it is essential that for the children's and adults safety that only the designated spaces are used.

There is no resident or nursery parking in the car park. There is free roadside parking locally which we would encourage people to use. We appreciate that this can be challenging at school drop offlicik up times.

Thank you for your support in ensuring that the car park is a safe place.
